## Council Recap

## October 15 Council Meeting

**See below for some decisions and announcements made during the last Town Council meeting on Tuesday, October 15.**

- An ordinance defining electric scooters was tabled until all Council members were in attendance. The discussion will continue during the November 5 meeting.
- A change to the Town's Municipal Code was approved in regards to the maximum imprisonment the Municipal Court can impose for certain misdemeanors.
- The Lavender Elephant received an extension on their Commercial Enhancement Grant as some of their improvements were delayed.
- Council approved two new connecting roads that are part of the Roam development.
- Council approved an agreement for Mountain Parks Electric to change 44 streetlights in town to LED.
- The Town reaffirmed the prohibition of overnight parking on town streets from Nov. 1 through May 1.
